Association/Union Account
(an organization of two or more persons organized to promote a common interest)

- 1. Registration of the Association with the appropriate governing entity or Articles of Association**

- 3. By-laws may be used in place of Articles of Association and/or registration of the association with the appropriate governing entity.**

Engine House Account
(Fire Station House Dues Account)

- 1. Copy of Bylaws (if they exist)**
